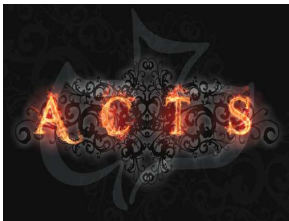

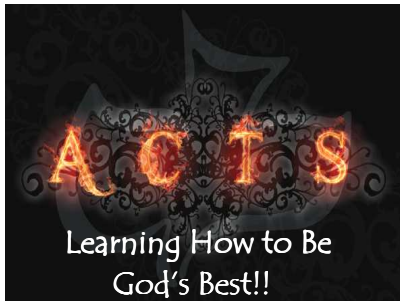

## Teaching Notes—ACTS 2:42-47 “A Picture of the Church” Speaker—Brian Clark

### Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

READ: [ACTS 2:42-47](#)

- Go around the room, and in a few words, describe how this passage makes you feel, or what you like best about it.
- “Justin, an early church writer 130 years after Acts, said this: “[we] follow the only unbegotten God through His Son... we who valued above all things the acquisition of wealth and possessions, **now bring what we have into a common stock, and communicate to every one in need...**[we who] would not live with men of a different tribe, now, since the coming of Christ, **live familiarly with them.**” Do you believe the church today should continue functioning in the same manner discussed in the Acts 2:42-47 passage? Do you think that we do things differently today than the church did early on? Is it good or bad? Why or why not?
- Read [Isaiah 58](#) and [Acts 9:36-42](#) and [Romans 12:9-20](#). Some within our congregation may be facing foreclosure, eviction, and/or homelessness. How do you believe a Spirit-filled, biblically grounded church would respond? Would you change your answer if they 'deserved' homelessness because of their lack of planning, or lavish lifestyle? What if they weren't a Christian? What if they were known to 'take advantage' of people?
- In what ways do you see 2RC being much like this passage? Do you see any areas that 2RC can/should improve in, with regard to this passage?
