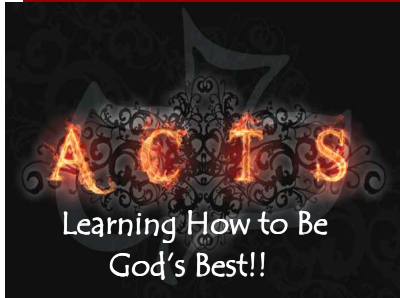

1. Claim the absolute **S**\_\_\_\_\_ of God in your life (vs. 24-26)
2. Declare God's rule over the entire **W**\_\_\_\_\_. (vs. 27-28)
3. Pray with **C**\_\_\_\_\_! (vs. 29-30)

#### Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

##### READ Acts 4:14-31

1. Who has taught you the most about prayer? How did they help you?
2. How do you feel about civil disobedience? (E.g. Some Christians feel it is against their religious to fight in the military.) When do you believe that it is right to defy the government?
3. How are your prayers similar or different to how the believers prayed here?
4. If God knows everything, why do the believers tell Him all the details in their prayer?
5. Look at vs. 28. What does this say about God's rule in your life—the good and bad things that happen?
6. If you were Peter or John, what would you have asked God for after the encounter with the Jewish Council?
7. What keeps you from being bold?—**The ability to do or say what is right, no matter the cost or consequences?**
8. Pray together for courage in a specific area.
