SERMON NOTES— Timothy and Epaphroditus - **Philippians 2:19-30**

--- Philippians 2:2 Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose.

We end Philippians 2 with a clear visual of what Paul was talking about at the beginning of Philippians 2.

To join in the struggle, the church body must be unified in:

Unified in faith- sharing a common belief

Unified in love- have a genuine concern for one another

Unified in mission- laboring together to continue the work of Jesus Christ

Unified against a shared enemy – battling together

Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

Read **Philippians 1:29-30**. Why do you think Paul felt it was so important to send Timothy to Philippi?

What kinds of things do you think the church of Philippi struggled with?

What kinds of things do we as the church body struggle with at 2RC?

Paul called Epaphroditus a brother, co-worker and fellow soldier. Paul & Epaphroditus were unified. They had faced struggles together and labored in the same mission. What is the mission of Two Rivers Church?

Read **Romans 12:4-5**. Do you think about your part in the body of Two Rivers Church? Do you think about your role in our shared mission?

Read **Matthew 28:16-20**. Do you labor in the mission Christ gave each of us?
