Three Observations about the Book of Psalms

1. The Psalms are meant to be instruction from God about life
2. The Psalms are poems / songs
Parallelism = A form of writing that uses a lot of repetition and contrast to make a point.
3. The Psalms are inspired by God

Psalm 1 Questions:

1. Why does the writer start the way he does? Comparing wickedness with the Word of God?
2. What is biblical meditation?
3. Can we find Jesus in Psalm 1?

Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

- Most of the Psalms were written using parallelism—poetic repetition and contrast. Can you find specific examples of these in **Psalm 1**? Read it together first.
- Jesus also used contrast to make a point. Can you find 5 contrasting examples in **Matthew 7:13-29**? Read it together first. Do you feel the tension personally?
- What are some real examples of people walking with the wicked, standing with sinners, and sitting with scoffers? Why is it so destructive? Can't we find the goodness of God in the people and ways of the world?
- What is the difference between biblical meditation and Eastern religion's meditation?
- How does a Christ-follower develop and maintain an attitude of delight rather than duty towards God's Word?
- Only the godly/righteous will survive the judgment. Read **2 Corinthians 5:21**. What has Jesus done so that we can be righteous before God?
