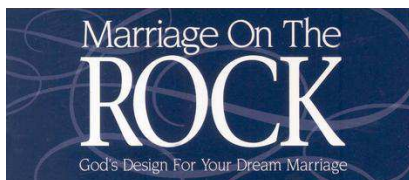

Do You Know Your A—B—C 's?

Psalm 25

Psalm 25 is one of the so-called Alphabet Psalms

Psalm 25 speaks to people who are in different seasons of life:

- 1) To those who need help
- 2) To those who need reminders
- 3) To those who need to respond in worship

Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

- 1) Do you have any vivid memories from early school years? (Pre-school, Kindergarten, 1st grade) Do you remember learning to write the alphabet?
- 2) Read **Psalm 25**. What words, phrases or ideas are repeated? Why do you think they are repeated?
- 3) What words or phrases in Psalm 25 indicate that David might have been asking for God's help? What help is he asking for?
- 4) Does God promise to always change our circumstances when we ask for His help? What does He promise? (Refer to **John 16:33** and **Deut. 31:6** for help in answering)
- 5) What indications do we have that David might have been trying to remind himself of God's truth in Psalm 25? Why do we as humans need reminders?
- 6) How do we see David worshipping God in this Psalm? Why is worshipping God like we see here and in other Psalms (like **Psalm 95:1-7**) so important?
- 7) Today, what would you say you need most? Help in a specific situation? A reminder about the truth of God? An opportunity to respond in worship? Spend some time praying for one another in these ways.
