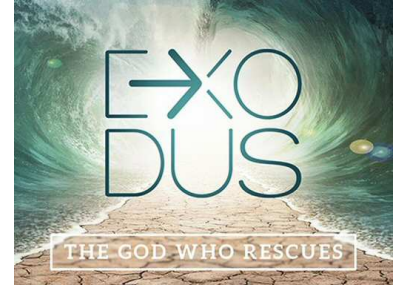

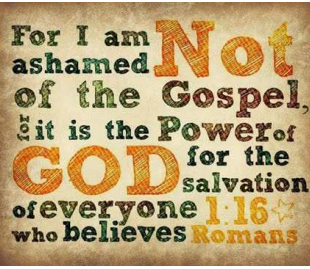

Sermon Notes: "Getting Ready for Exodus!"

The "3 R's" of the Bible Reading Experiment:

1. READ

- * Read the assigned passage 2-3 times in your small group
 - it's ok to use different Bible versions—although we recommend NLT, NIV or ESV
 - resist the temptation to ask questions or get side-tracked. Simply read in order to know and remember the Bible story.

2. REMEMBER

- * Now go around the circle and try to remember the exact sequence or what happened and what was said in the passage you read.
 - try to do this with your Bibles closed
 - it's ok to correct someone if it's out of order (just be nice!)
 - again, resist the temptation to ask questions, look at study notes, or give your interpretation of what was read.

3. RESEARCH

- * Then after #1 & #2, you can research and interpret what happened or what was said. This is the perfect time to ask questions—Who, What, Why, When, Where, How?
- * Try to personalize the text and apply it to your lives. Listen for what God is saying to you through these words.
- * This section may be directed by a teacher or group leader.

Practice texts: Luke 17:11-17
Matthew 4:18-22

Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

- Explain the Bible Reading Experiment that Pastor Rob wants the congregation to do every Sunday morning during the teaching series in EXODUS. Remember the "3 R's" - Read, Remember, Research.
- Practice with Luke 10:25-37.
- After going through the READ and REMEMBER sections, ask questions you might have and discuss the following:
 - * Why do you think the Levite and Priest didn't stop to help the injured man?
 - * What reaction do you think the listening Jews had when they realized the hero of the story is Samaritan?
 - * Have you ever been helped by a stranger?
 - * How does this parable answer the question, "Who is my neighbor"?
 - * Be ready for opportunities to put Jesus' story into personal practice. Ask God for the opportunity to be a Good Samaritan and be willing to help—even a stranger.
