Sermon Notes: Mark 6:1-13

The Faith that Follows

Luke 4:4-30 Jesus is rejected by his hometown

1. Verses 1-6: Jesus is again rejected by His hometown

2. Verses 7-13: Jesus sends out the 12

Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

1. Mark 6 begins with the people of Jesus's home-town rejecting Him. Share about a time when you faced rejection. Was it among family or friends? Was it while sharing Jesus? Describe your emotions.
2. Read **John 1:11**. What does it mean to you to know that Jesus faced rejection?
3. The unbelief of the Nazarenes hindered Jesus from performing more than just a few miracles. Is faith required to be healed?
4. Why do you think Jesus sent the disciples out two by two? Think of the advantages. Read **Ecclesiastes 4:9-12**. Is there wisdom here for us today?
5. Jesus instructed the disciples to shake the dust off of their sandals if they were not welcomed, or listened to. In this action, they were saying "I wash my hands of this...I have done all that can be done". How do we reconcile this with ministry today? How do we decide today when to move on, after sharing the gospel, and when to stay giving patient testimony?
