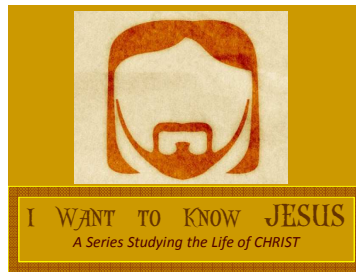

SERMON NOTES— "I Want To Know Jesus"

Main Text:

Today: Jesus, Politics, and Earthly Kingdoms

Home Group Discussion & BIBLE STUDY for this week:

1. Have you ever been involved in a strike, sit-in, or other activist cause?
2. Read **2 Corinthians 10:3-6**. What does this verse mean to you today?
3. Read **Mark 4:1-20**. Is it possible that "cares of this world" could include not just riches or material possessions, but "causes" or even worrying about current events?
(Hint, think of Judas and the Pharisees that condemned Jesus to death)
4. Read **Psalms 22:28, Daniel 4:32, Romans 13:1-2**. Do you believe this is an absolute mandate? Are there any exceptions? (Hint **Acts 5:12-42**)
5. Considering everything, if Jesus were to ask you to pick one "cause" or kingdom to fight for, what would it be, and how do you think he would ask you to fight for it?

Further study:

Read **Mark 4:1-20**: Have you ever chased a cause that ultimately distracted you to the point of fruitlessness or near-fruitlessness?

What causes do you see today that are solely aimed at building earthly kingdoms?

Most causes want you to "take action now". Even Jesus' disciples tried to protect him with swords. Remembering Jesus' "inaction" in the garden, meditate on **Lamentations 3:1-26**.
