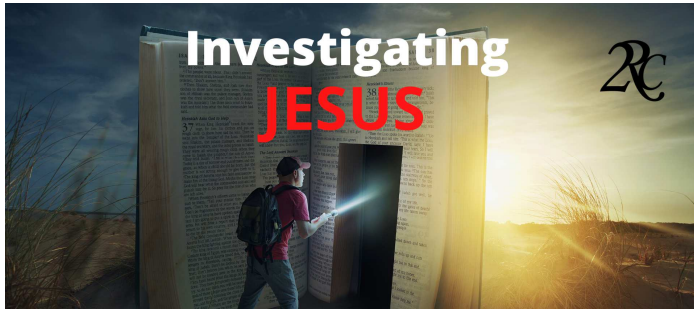
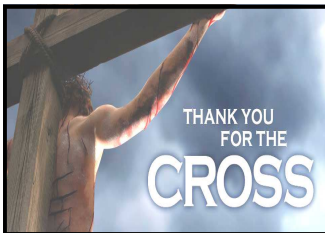

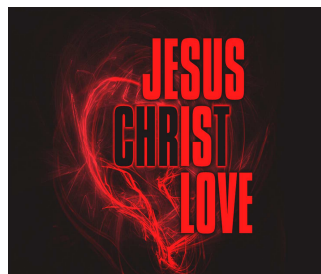

HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **ICEBREAKER**— If you could see one movie again for the first time, what would it be and why?
- We can't help everyone, but how do we decide who to help and who not to help?
- Read **Luke 10:25-37**. In verses 25-28, what stands out to you about how Jesus responded to the law expert's initial question?
- In **vs.29**, the law expert asked Jesus, "Who is my neighbor?" How would you answer that question. Who is your neighbor?
- In the parable in **vs. 30-35**, the Samaritan did no less than six kind acts to assist the injured man. Why do you think Jesus had the Samaritan do so many acts of kindness in the parable? Why not just one or two?
- Jesus says to the listeners of the parable to "Go and do likewise." • Who is it who needs your help? • What do you need to do in order to "go and do likewise?" • Is there anything preventing you from doing it?
