

**Joshua 2**

**Rahab—From Fear to Faith**

**Jenny Jones**

1. On the heels of 3 commands, from the Lord, to be strong & courageous. On the heels of the peoples assurance to Joshua that they will be strong & courageous, we enter the story of Rahab.
2. Joshua secretly sent out two spies. Echoes of Numbers 13:32-33
3. Vs. 1 Prostitute = Hebrew word Zanah meaning Harlot.  
Prior to Joshua 2, Moses had used this word in Numbers 25:1-3 to describe the actions of the Israelites while camped in Shittim.
4. How has Rahab been remembered? As a harlot and a liar? Hebrews 11:31 & James 2:25
5. Vs. 10 For we have heard... Deuteronomy 2:24-25
6. Vs. 14 Our lives for yours!
7. Vs. 18 Scarlet Cord= Hebrew word Tiqvah meaning hope, live, thing I long for
8. Vs. 18 compared to Exodus 12:22 Passover Images
9. Job 28:28 NLT The fear of the Lord is true wisdom; to forsake evil is real understanding.
10. Matthew 1:5

### HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Our biggest regrets are typically our “inactions”. Share an example of a time when fear kept you from taking action when you should have.
- Read **Numbers 13:24-33 & Numbers 14:1-4**. Who did they fear? Who did they trust?
- Contrast/compare this section of verses to the words of the spies sent in Joshua 2. What is different this time?
- Read the words spoken by Rahab alone, in **Joshua 2:8-13**. Discuss what these words reveal about Rahab.
- What is Rahab saying about God in v.11? Why is this such an amazing admission for Rahab?
- Read **Hebrews 11:1 & 11:31** NIV. What can we learn about the kind of faith that pleases God from Rahab?
