Sermon Notes: Joshua 6 The Fall of Jericho Rob Classen

#### <u>Victory Principles from the fall of Jericho:</u>

- 1. The victory is already won. Our part is to claim the victory
- 2. Follow through with God's plan—even when it doesn't make any sense
- 3. Thank God in advance for the victory—worship
- 4. Wait for God's timing—patience
- 5. God gets the first-fruits of your victory

#### HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- ICEBREAKER— Share a time when you did a crazy, spontaneous thing. How did it go for you?
- Read **Joshua 6:1-5.** What is significant about the words God uses and its (grammar)? (v s. 2) How do you think the Israelites felt about Joshua's battle plan?
- Joshua 6:6-14 essentially repeats the earlier verses. Read **Joshua 6:15-23**. What purpose is served by the number 7? The trumpets constant blowing? The ark's position? The people's shout? Why did God get the plunder of Jericho? How does this relate to the biblical idea of first-fruits?
- Of the 5 life principles for personal victory in the sermon notes which is the hardest for you to do? Which is the easiest? How do you claim a spiritual victory?
- Read **Proverbs3:5-6**. Try to apply these words to the "Victory Principles" written above.
- What is the biggest area in your life where you need a spiritual victory?
