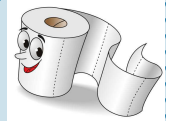

HOME GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- ICEBREAKER— What's the most formal/fancy ceremony you've participated in?
- Read **Genesis 12:1-7**. This is the starting point of our story in Joshua 8. Now read **Joshua 8:30-32**. Sheckem is right under Mt. Ebal. What is significant about Joshua building the altar where Abraham also did 400 years earlier?
- Read **Deuteronomy 27:1-9**. The altar at Sheckem was very significant to Moses, Joshua, and God. Remember the entire Israelite people had to hike 20 miles to get to it. Why do you think it was so important?
- Read **Joshua 8:33-35**. Why was it important for all of the Israelites to offer burnt offerings to the Lord and review the Book of the Law? Why do you think the children and foreigners were included in this spiritual ritual?
- Following the Israelites' example, how should we respond when the Lord gives us victory over a sin or weakness?
